Instructions:

1. **All Grade 10 students must select 10 classes** (Choral, Band, Vocal Jazz, Instrumental Jazz may be taken in addition to the 10 required classes.)

If I take an additional Science 20 in grade 10, which Science 20 should I choose? We encourage students to take Physical Science 20 in grade 11 rather than their grade 10 year. The other 3 Science 20's are good picks for grade 10 if chosen. Think about which 30 level science classes you plan on taking later in high school. The prerequisites are included below.

- **Physical Science 20:** allows you to take Physics 30, Chem 30, Earth Science 30
- **Environmental Science 20:** allows you to take Biology 30, Earth Science 30
- **Health Science 20:** allows you to take Biology 30
- **Computer Science 20:** allows you to take Computer Science 30
