Instructions:

1. **All Grade 12 students must select a minimum of 8 classes (maximum 10 classes)** (Choral, Band, Vocal Jazz, Instrumental Jazz may be taken in addition to the 8 required classes.)

A. Catholic Studies

C. Math

- **Students are required to have a minimum of a Math 10 and Math 20 level credit to meet the Ministry of Education Graduation requirements.** Students can register for additional math courses.
- Grade 12 Math Advanced Placement (AP): Students will select Calculus 30AP AND Integral Calculus 30. **AP classes are provided in English only.**
- **If you do not have a credit in a Math 20 course, please select one of the Math 20 options.**

D. Science

- **Students must have at least one 20 level Science to fulfill Ministry of Education requirements.** If you do not have a credit in a Science 20 class, please select one of the 20 level options. Students can register for additional Science 20 or 30 courses.
- **Courses are available in English only.**
- **Students will review their school transcript to determine which Science 20 class(es) were taken in their Grade 11 year and then select the appropriate 30-level Science class based on the prerequisites below. Students can access their transcript in the Student Portal of My School Sask by clicking on the “Transcript” side tab and selecting “Graduation Summary.” A check mark will appear next classes the student has received credit for.**

Prerequisites for 30-level Science Classes:

- **Physical Science 20:** Required for Physics 30, Chem 30, Earth Science 30
- **Environmental Science 20:** Required for Biology 30, Earth Science 30
- **Health Science 20:** Required for Biology 30
- **Computer Science 20:** Required for Computer Science 30

Computer Science 30 (AP) course is taught through the RCSD online school.

E. Social Sciences

Students must select a minimum of one course from the Social Science list to fulfill Ministry of Education Requirements. Additional classes may be selected. **Psychology Advanced students will select Psych 20AD and Psych 30AP.** French Immersion students can select from Histoire 20 or Sciences Sociales Immersion 30. Francais students will select Francais classes as priority and are eligible to select English classes as well.

Note: Grade 12 students are required to have one of the following to graduate.

F. Electives

All Grade 12 students must select a minimum of 8 classes (Choral, Band, Vocal Jazz, Instrumental Jazz may be taken in addition to the 8 required classes.) **Students should select 30 level electives** but may need to select a 20-level class depending on prerequisite requirements and credits earned.

All Grade 12 students must select a minimum of 8 classes – 10 classes recommended. (Choral, Band, Vocal Jazz, Instrumental Jazz may be taken in addition to the 10 recommended classes.)

Students taking AP Visual Art are required to select Visual Art 30 (AP) and Studio Art 30 (2 credits).

Refer to the Grade 10-12 Course Booklet 2025-26 to see elective descriptions.
