Welcome to the Grade 11 Subject Selection. All information contained within this document can be found on our school website under <u>Subject Selection</u> under the Student Services top tab.

Instructions:

- 1. All Grade 11 students must select a minimum of 8 classes (maximum 10 classes) (Choral, Band, Vocal Jazz, Instrumental Jazz may be taken in addition to the 8 required classes.)
- 2. Log on to MySchoolSask (MSS).
- 3. Click on the link <u>Student Instructions for Subject Selection</u> and review. This will provide visuals on how to select subjects.
- 4. Begin selecting subjects within the categories below. Selections are based on the English or French program.

A. Catholic Studies

Select Catholic Studies 20 as it is compulsory. If you have not completed Catholic Studies 10, please select.

B. Languages

English Program: These are compulsory classes.

- Students can add Creative Writing 20 (not compulsory)
- If you have not completed ELA 10, please select.

- Students will choose Francais 20 + ELA 20 OR ELA 20 (Advanced)
- Students can add Creative Writing 20 (not compulsory)

C. Math

- English and French Immersion students are required to select A MINIMUM OF ONE Math 20 class from the list of options. Additional math classes may be selected.
- Grade 11 Math Advanced Placement (AP) Pathway: <u>Students will select Math 20 Pre-Calculus AND Math 30 Pre-Calculus</u> (Courses are provided in English or French)
- If you have not earned credit in a Math 10 course, please select one of the Math 10 options.

D. Science

- Students must have <u>at least one 20 level</u> Science to fulfill Ministry of Education Requirements. Students can register for additional Science 20 courses.
- If you do not have a credit in Science 10, please select.
- Courses are available in English only.
- Think about which Science 30 classes you plan on taking in the future to determine which 20 level Science classes you will select. (Please see the description of prerequisites in step 2 below.)
- **Step 1:** Students will choose from one or more of the 4 prerequisite 20 level courses below prior to choosing a 30-level course.
 - Health Science 20
 - Environmental Science 20
 - Physical Science 20
 - Computer Science 20
- **Step 2:** Students may choose an additional Science class(es) based on the following prerequisite requirements:
 - Physical Science 20: Required for Physics 30, Chem 30, Earth Science 30
 - Environmental Science 20: Required for Biology 30, Earth Science 30
 - **Health Science 20**: Required for Biology 30
 - Computer Science 20: Required for Computer Science 30

The Advanced Computer Science 30 class is taught at the RCSD online school.

Students must select a minimum of ONE COURSE from the Social Science list BELOW to fulfill Ministry of Education Requirements. *Psychology Advanced students must select Psych 20 AD and Psych 30 AP (2 credits). French Immersion students can select Histoire 20 or Sciences Sociales Immersion 30. Select either Native Studies 10, History 10 or Histoire 10 (French Immersion) if you have not earned a Social Science Grade 10 credit.
