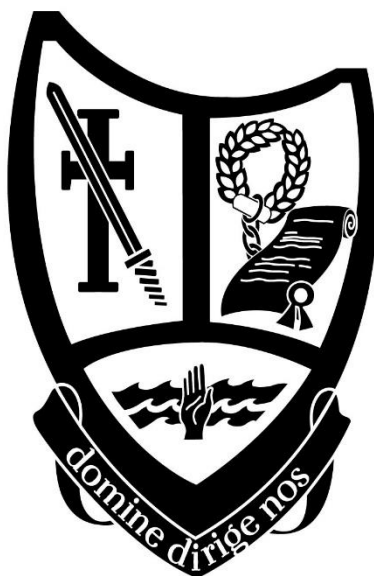

Grad Timeline 2025

November/December	Grad Photos • Times and Dates TBA • Information from Lifetouch will be sent out • Sign up online • Photo sessions are at O'Neill
September/April	Grad List Grad list posted outside the main office in September and April. Students need to confirm that the spelling of their name is correct.
October	Grad Fee Collection (School Cash Online) • Graduation fees have been added to your child's SchoolCash account and must be paid using this platform. • The \$104.75 fee will cover the following items: graduation cap, tassel, gown, stole, rental of Conexus, program printing, graduation composite, portfolios, certificate printing, decorations, audio-visual/equipment rentals and graduate sign. • Please note all students will receive a cap and tassel, gown and stole to keep. Grads will be asked to inform the office of their height for their grad gown.
June 6	Grad Eligibility Date • Graduation eligibility is defined as a student who has the potential to earn a minimum of 24 credit units, including Catholic Studies 30, and the compulsory requirements outlined by the Ministry of Education. Must have a passing grade in all required courses by June 6th.
June 23	Grad Rehearsal and Gown Distribution • June 23rd- 11:30 (After CFD #4) • Gowns will be distributed after rehearsal • MANDATORY for all graduates • More details will be sent out through Grade 12 Edsby and school announcements
June 24	Graduation Mass • Resurrection Parish (3155 Windsor Park Rd) • 2:00 p.m. • Grads sit with family • Grads wear blue grad gown. No cap or stole.
June 25	Graduation Exercises • Conexus Art Center (200 Lakeshore Dr.) • 9:00 a.m. • Grads must arrive by 8:15 a.m. • Grads wear blue grad gown, cap, tassel and stole. • General seating. Doors open to guests at 8:30.

Grad Eligibility

In order to participate in the graduation mass and exercises, a student attending a Regina Catholic High School must be deemed graduation eligible. Graduation eligibility will be defined as a student who has the potential to earn a minimum of 24 credit units, including Catholic Studies 30 and the compulsory requirements outlined by the Ministry of Education.

A determination of a student's eligibility will be made on June 6th and is dependent upon a student having a passing grade in all required courses. Summer school will no longer be considered when determining graduation eligibility.

Valedictorian & Salutatorian

Valedictorian is an academic title conferred upon the student who delivers the closing or farewell statement at the graduation ceremony to recognize the successful completion of their studies (called a valedictory).

The Valedictorian will be a graduating student who has attended Archbishop M. C. O'Neill Catholic High School for at least two full years and has attained the **highest average** (using all grade 11 year and grade 12 year subjects) at the start of April 2025.

The Salutatorian's role as the first speaker at a graduation ceremony is to deliver the salutatory welcoming address.

The Salutatorian will be a graduating student who has attended Archbishop M. C. O'Neill Catholic High School for at least two full years and who has attained the **second highest average** (using all grade 11 year and grade 12 year subjects) at the start of April 2025.

The Valedictorian and Salutatorian are required to carry a minimum class load of seven (7) classes. Students who have been suspended during their senior year will not be allowed to speak at graduation.

Grade 12 EDSBY

All grade 12 students have been added to the 2025 Gr. 12 EDSBY Group. Information relating to grad will be posted in the group as it becomes available.
